All teachers, staff, and students will wear mask in the Coffeeville School District for the 2021-2022 school year. The Coffeeville School District strongly encourages all eligible persons to become fully vaccinated to further prevent and control the spread of COVID-19. Parents and visitors will **not** be allowed entry into the school building during the instructional day. However, parents and visitors are encouraged to contact District personnel via phone or email to discuss matters of importance.

Other COVID-19 Guidance:

- Masks should be worn on the school bus as well as in the school settings by all individuals (age 2 and older).
- Teachers and students will maintain at least 3 feet of physical distance in classrooms, hallways, cafeteria, and gymnasium, combined with mask wearing to reduce transmission risk.
- Routine screening testing of asymptomatic unvaccinated students, teachers and staff is recommended as an additional measure to prevent further transmission.
- COVID-19 infected students, teachers, and staff will be isolated and continue contact tracing to identify exposed individuals for quarantine and exclusion from the school setting.
- All students, teachers and staff who have symptoms of any infectious illness, regardless of vaccination status, should stay home from school and be evaluated by their healthcare provider.
- Teachers and staff who miss more than the allotted number of sick/ personal days will be docked from their pay.
- Fully vaccinated students, teachers and staff:
 - Do not have to quarantine or be excluded from the school setting if they have COVID-19 exposure; and
 - Do not have to be tested unless symptomatic.
