COVID-19 Procedural Policy		March 10, 2022

The wearing of masks is now optional and a personal choice while on the school campus and when riding the bus. The Coffeeville School District will continue to do our part to minimize the spread of COVID by maintaining hand sanitizing stations on all campuses and disinfecting classrooms after school hours, However, if you are immunocompromised or high risk for severe illness, please discuss with your healthcare professional the need to wear a mask and take additional precautions. The Coffeeville School District strongly encourages all eligible persons to become fully vaccinated to further prevent and control the spread of COVID-19.

Other COVID-19 Guidance:

- Masks are <u>not</u> required on the school bus as well as in the school settings unless for health or other personal reasons.
- Routine screening testing of asymptomatic unvaccinated students, teachers and staff is recommended as an additional measure to prevent further transmission.
- COVID-19 infected students, teachers, and staff will be isolated and continue contact tracing to identify exposed individuals for quarantine and exclusion from the school setting. Students, teachers, and staff may return to the school setting with proof of a negative COVID-19 test result.
- All students, teachers and staff who have symptoms of any infectious illness, regardless of vaccination status, should stay home from school and be evaluated by their healthcare provider.
- Student, teacher, or staff member who test positive for COVID-19 must quarantine or be excluded from the school setting until proof of a negative COVID-19 test has been submitted to Principal or Supervisor.
- Teachers and staff who miss more than the allotted number of sick/ personal days will be docked from their pay.
- Students, teachers, staff who have been boosted or fully vaccinated within the last six months:
 - Do not have to quarantine or be excluded from the school setting if they have COVID-19 exposure; and
 - o Do not have to be tested unless symptomatic.
