The following is a brief listing of educational parenting tips that can be used to help your scholar experience academic success in the classroom and on the Mississippi Academic Assessment Program (MAAP):

1. Make sure your scholar is at school every day.
2. Encourage your scholar to exhibit good behavior, listen to teachers, and to put forth his/her best efforts in school each day.
3. Provide your scholar with a quiet learning area whereby he/she may complete all homework assignments upon arrival from school.
4. Check your scholar's work. Make sure all homework assignments have been properly completed.
5. Formulate strong partnerships and positive working relationships with your scholar's teacher. Give your scholar's teacher the support that he/she needs to properly educate your child. Keep in contact with your scholar's teacher by phone or email to check on his/her academic and behavioral progress.
6. Make time for reading at home. Encourage your son/daughter to read his/her Accelerated Reader book(s) and other books for 30-60 minutes daily.
7. Provide computer with internet access at home. You and your scholar may practice skills taught in the classroom by visiting educational websites such as www.khanacademy.org.
